- Created in 2008
- Collaboration of CU-Anschutz, CU-Denver, CU Boulder, CSU, 6 hospitals and >20 community organizations
- Funded primarily by NIH CTSA grant

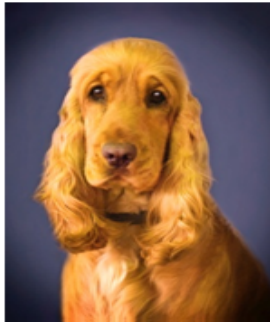
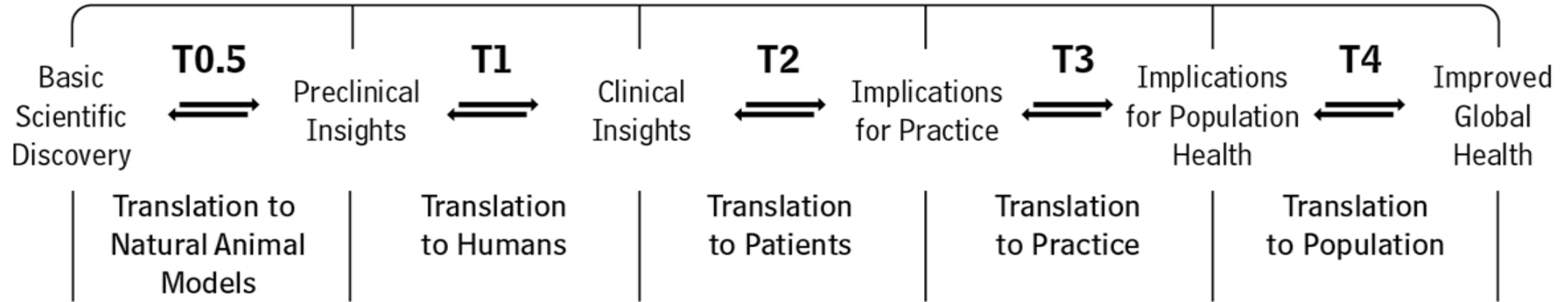
