\*No more than 21 credits of certificate coursework can transfer into the MPH program, if completed prior to MPH matriculation. If completing the MPH and Certificate in Maternal and Child Health concurrently, a maximum of 9 credits can be applied towards both programs. Students in the Certificate in Maternal and Child Health designate the CU Anschutz Medical Campus as their home campus and are required to take a minimum of 9 credits from that campus. Online courses are designated to the campus from which they originate as listed in the class schedule, with the exception of PUBH 6600. PUBH 6600: Foundations in Public Health or its equivalent on any CSPH campus can be applied as home campus credit toward the certificate.
