<b>Student Responsibilities:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>In order to complete the requirements of the Research Paper, the final paper needs to be in a format suitable for submission to a medical/scientific journal. The co-authors and supervising CSPH faculty will make this final determination.</li> <li>Students will register for a total of 2 credits of 6650 or PUBH 6651, taken as a block or as single credits over their last two semesters.</li> <li>The student is also required to register for 1 credit of PUBH 6991: MPH Capstone Integration. This should preferably take place during the term the student expects to complete their project and graduate, as there is a requirement that students be registered for at least one course in the final semester of their MPH program. The final presentation of the Research Paper results will be within the context of the Public Health Forum.</li> <li>When the final paper has been approved, a copy should be forwarded to the Office of Academic Affairs to retain in the student file.</li> </ul>
