USMLE Step 1 or COMLEX Exam

Osteopathic students must have successfully passed USMLE Step 1 **or** the COMLEX exam prior to participating in CU School of Medicine electives.

Administrative Fee

\$4,000 per 4 week elective for Non-Colorado Residents

\$2,000 per 4 week elective for Colorado Residents – (Colorado residency form required for verification).

Administrative Fee Reduction for Primary Care

The CU School of Medicine Curriculum Steering Committee has approved a 75% administrative fee reduction for certain primary care electives. These are limited only to:

FMMD 8002 – Family Medicine Subinternship

FMMD 8007 – Out-Patient Family Medicine

MEDS 8001 – Medicine Subinternship

MEDS 8023 – Medicine Consult

PEDS 8000 – Pediatric Subinternship

PEDS 8007 – Child Abuse and Neglect

PHMD 8000 – Physical Medicine and Rehab
