



Change the language of your Chrome browser:

For PCs (Windows) and Chromebooks:

1. On your computer, open Chrome.
2. At the top right of the browser window, click “More  ”, then find “Settings” near the bottom.
3. On the left side of the screen, a list appears, click “Advanced”.
4. Find "Languages," click Language.
5. Next to the language you'd like to use, click “More  ”.
 - If the language isn't listed, add it by clicking “Add languages”.
6. Click “Display Google Chrome in this language” or “Display Chrome OS in this language”.
 - This option is only available on Windows and Chromebook computers.
7. Restart Chrome to apply the changes.

On Mac or Linux:

Chrome will automatically display in the default system language for your computer. You do not need to make any setting changes
