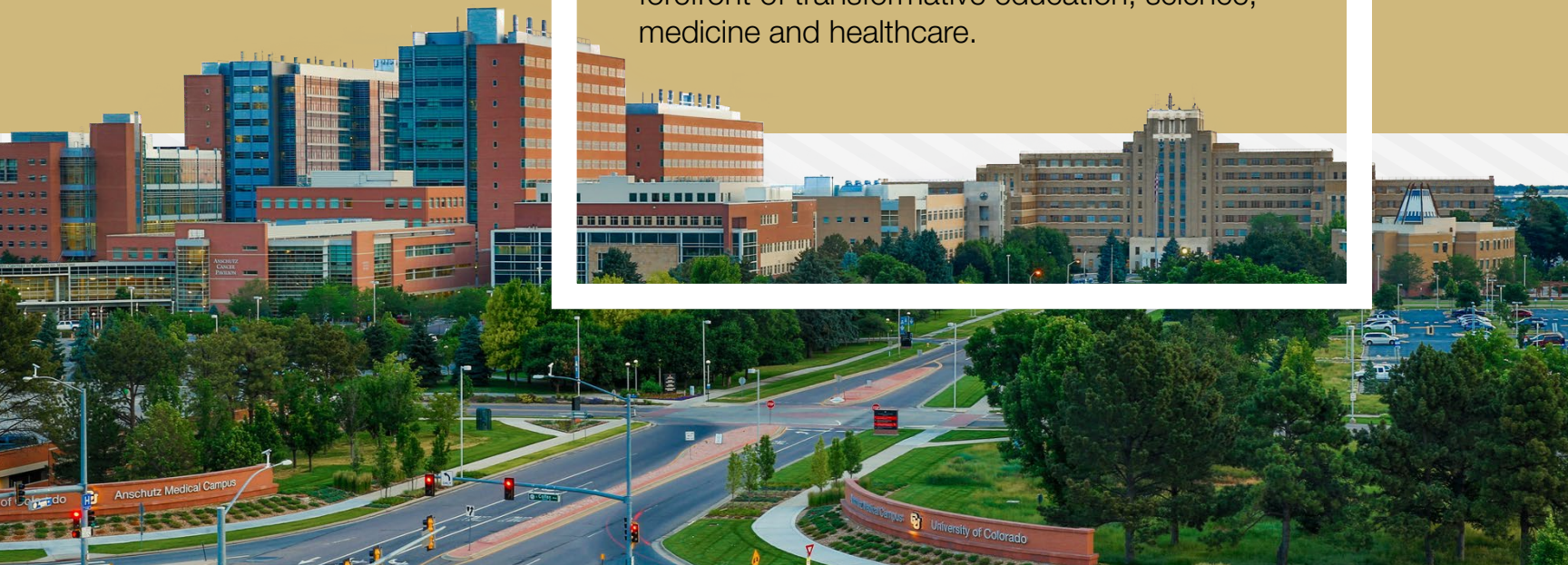

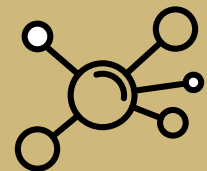

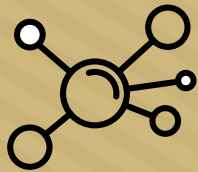

- **The Office for Educational Outreach and Pathway Initiatives** works with middle, high school and college students from diverse backgrounds and identities who are interested in the health professions and STEM fields, providing programs, resources and guidance.
- **The Community Engagement Program** empowers nearby neighborhoods to develop self-advocacy and entrepreneurialism. Work includes the **Resident Leadership Council**, which has 24 community leaders working alongside more than 400 neighbors in one-to-one interviews to identify concerns, aspirations and needs.
- **The El Alba Cooperative** is a catering cooperative that operates food trucks throughout the Denver metro area to improve social determinants of health. In FY22, they sold more than \$170,000 in meals.
- **DAWN Health**, created by CU School of Medicine students, provides free basic healthcare to underserved Aurora residents.
- **CU Dental Medicine** sees more than 100,000 patient visits in low-cost dental clinics.

Our newest campus landmark, the 396,000-square-foot Anschutz Health Sciences Building (AHSB) is helping to drive the next generation of translational health science research, mental and behavioral health, education and personalized clinical care.

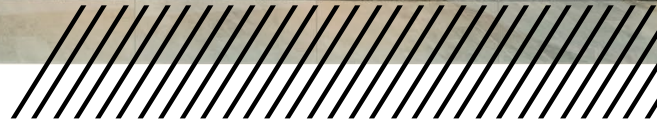
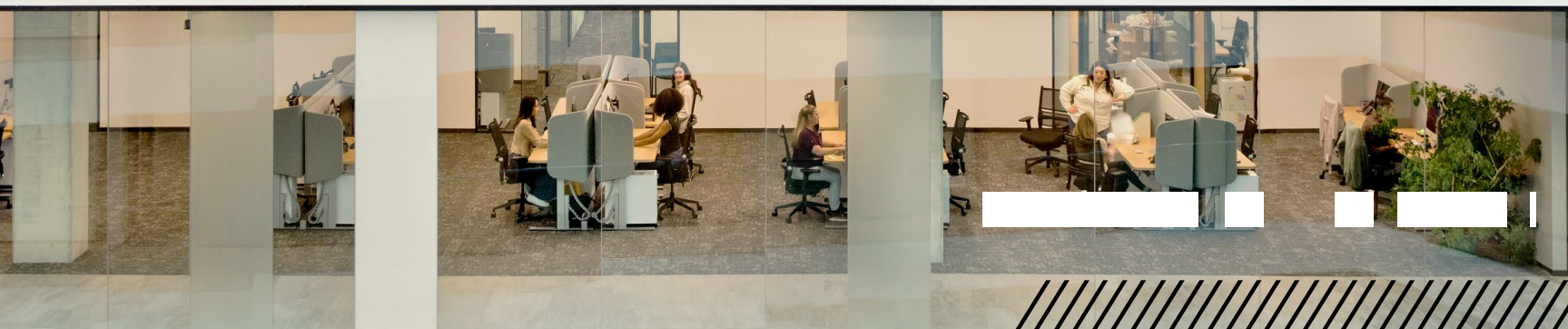
